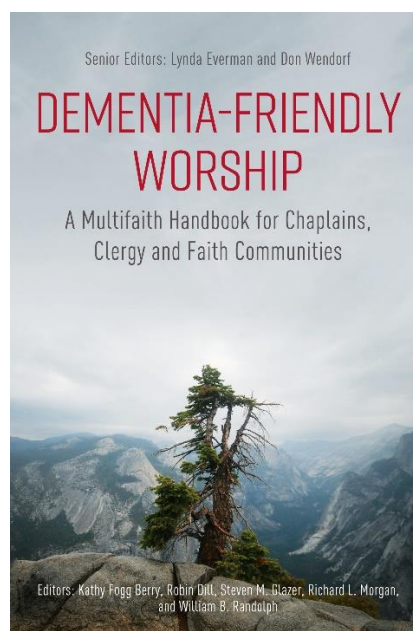
We are committed to creating dementia friendly faith communities.
